Disposal of Medicine and Medical Waste

Storing unwanted and expired medications at home presents a risk for drug abuse and overdose for consumers as well as children and pets. On the other hand, improper drug disposal can contaminate soil and water, if people trash or flush pharmaceuticals down the sink or drain. **Fort Worth has a variety of ways to dispose of medications:**

1. **Collection Events**– The city holds take-back events in the spring and fall. Please monitor your utility bill for the announcement of collection dates. Please visit www.fortworthtexas.gov/takebackmeds for a list of upcoming dates.
2. **Drug Take-Back Kiosks**– There are currently three Drug Take-Back Kiosks in Fort Worth that are available 24 hours a day, seven days a week: UNT Health Science Center located inside the police station on campus at 3600 Mattison Ave., Walgreens at 6205 Westcreek Drive and Walgreens at 4520 Western Center Blvd. If you are unable to drop off your unused pharmaceuticals, please contact Jennifer Nanni at 817-688-3005. She can arrange for a pick-up and drop them off at UNTHSC where she currently works.
3. **Drug Take-Back Envelopes**– For small quantities of medications, the city is piloting a take-back program through postal mail. Simply call 817-392-1234 or email 1234@fortworthtexas.gov to request a postage-paid envelope (limited to one envelope per household while supplies last).
4. **Police Station Collection Boxes**– There are five locations Monday-Friday from 8 a.m. to 5.p.m. at Central Division at 501 Jones St., East Division at 1100 Nashville, North Division at 2500 North Houston St., South Division at 3128 West Bolt St., and West Division at 3525 Marquita.

Medical Waste:

1. Sharps (needles, syringes, lancets)- Before throwing away sharps in a trash receptacle, place them in a sharps disposal container or hard plastic/metal with a tightly-secured lid. Please break off syringe needles to prevent reuse, if possible.
2. General Medical Waste– Place IV bags, tubing and similar equipment in plastic garbage bags and throw them away in a trash receptacle. **These items are NOT**
