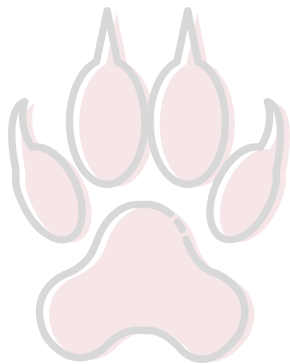

# Neighborhood Feral Cat Population

Several neighbors have recently expressed concern over a rising feral cat population within our neighborhood. There are quite a few affordable local programs available to help including this one by the Humane Society of North Texas.

TNR is Trap Neuter Release program at The Humane Society Spay and Neuter clinic. The TNR program is on the first and last Tuesday of every month for stray and feral cats. No appointment is needed, drop off is between 7:30-9:00am and pick-up is between 3- 5 pm the same day, 1 cat per trap, humane traps only. All other forms of carriers and cages will be denied. No more than 3 feral/stray cats per household on a single TNR day. The cost is \$25 per cat, includes surgery, rabies vaccination, and their ear tipped.

"FREE spay/neuter, rabies vaccination and microchip package for dogs and cats of Fort Worth residents. Must receive spay/or neuter to qualify for free rabies shot and microchip. All others residents will receive our regular low prices. The purpose of the 'Taken' It to the Streets campaign is to achieve a reduction in the accidental pet births through an aggressive sterilization program to lower shelter intake and euthanasia rates in the City of Fort Worth, reduce the number of owner surrender animals through a strong educational program and make our city a safer and more humane community for pets and people.

park in the garage if you can, leave a light  
on, and use a security system if possible.  
The newer smart technology door bell video  
cameras are extremely effective in helping  
combat theft and vandalism.

Do not park on the street if you can. Lots of  
cars parked on the road increases likelihood  
of burglary and theft.
