Councilman Byrd shared with us some recent City Council achievements, as well as updates on issues being considered in the current state legislative session that impact school funding, property taxes, etc. He also shared updates on the progress of the LVT Rise project. Councilman Byrd also has yard signs available -- he is up for reelection in the upcoming May 4th local elections!

We had some great discussion reviewing the results of the recent neighborhood survey, and identified several neighborhood traffic safety issues to work on.

We discussed the status of the church renovation project, upcoming events, and welcomed new neighbors.

Tabitha Butler, our city liaison, provided an informative presentation on all of the city services available to us as individuals as well as a neighborhood organization.

Mike Narramore shared updates on the new Ridglea Hills Addition/Bomber Heights joint Neighborhood Watch and Citizens on Patrol program. The first monthly meeting will be next Monday on April 1st from 6 to 6:30 PM at Agape Baptist Church and

[Code Compliance Corner: Fences](#)

Fences help keep children and pets safe.

Fences can also deter potential theft, by keeping items in our back yard out of view. Fences can also keep would-be thieves from being able to easily enter our backyards and be unobserved. City of Fort Worth code states that residential fences should be maintained in good condition and should not be out of vertical alignment by more than 18 degrees. Now is a good time to look at the fencing around your yard, before spring leaves start to sprout.



- Are wooden slats in good repair?
- Are any slats missing that should be replaced?
- Do any trees or bushes need to be trimmed to take weight off of fencing so that it stays properly vertical?
- Do any posts need to be replaced?
- Do locks or gates need to be repaired or replaced?

Keeping fences in good repair benefits you and makes the neighborhood more attractive.
